- All current and upcoming invoices can be viewed in your Opus1 account
- We accept **Zelle** and **credit card** payments
- To receive a **sales tax credit**, Zelle payments must be submitted **before 8:00 PM on the last day of the month**
- Zelle payments sent after 8:00 PM will be processed in the next billing cycle, and sales tax will still apply to the current invoice
- Credit card payments may be made on the due date to avoid late fees
